


Trip Itinerary

Day 1: Travel to Amsterdam, Netherlands

- Cost= \$1,938





Day 2: Visit Anne Frank's House



- Cost 9 euro (\$10.04)
- Anne Frank had to go into hiding during World War Two to escape the Nazis' persecution of the Jews. She was discovered and sent to a concentration camp where she died. The place where Anne hid from 1942 to 1944 is known as the secret annex. In the museum you can see Anne Frank's original diary, which she wrote while in hiding. The museum tells the story of how the eight people in hiding lived and who helped them.

This relates to our study of the Holocaust, the genocide of the Jewish people by the Nazis during WWII.

Day 2 continued: Visit the Vincent Van Gogh Museum

- Cost 17 euros (\$18.95)
- Art museum dedicated to the works of Dutch painter, Vincent van Gogh and his contemporaries.

Day 3: Visit to Keukenhof Gardens



- Cost 16 euro (\$17.84)
- known as the Garden of Europe, is one of the world's largest flower gardens. It is situated outside of Amsterdam. Approximately 7 million flower bulbs are planted annually in the park, which covers an area of 79 acres.

Take a bike ride 4.4 miles away to see the tulip fields in Bollenstreek





 - Cost = \$207 per night at 2 nights= \$414






Day 4: Visit the State Hermitage Museum (Winter Palace)


This relates to when we studied the Russian Revolution and Tzar Nicholas was overthrown and killed along with his family.

- Tzar Nicholas Romanov was the last king to live here.






Day 5: Visit the Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood & boat tour of the city




- One of the main attractions in the city
- Known for its ornately decorated onion domes and stunning mosaics inside



Day 6: Travel to Moscow & Visit Red Square & Lenin's Masoleum

Lenin led the Bolshevik
Revolution and took control
of Russia, creating a
communist state and
renaming it the Union of
Soviet Socialist Republics
(USSR).

- It's the symbolic center of all of Russia
- Separates the Kremlin (residence of President)
 and the merchant section of the city
- Contains the embalmed body of Vladimir Lenin, the founder of the USSR






Where to Stay in Moscow: Ararat Park Hyatt Moscow

Day 7: Visit St. Basil's Cathedral & Attend a Russian ballet




- Cost 250 rubles (\$4.85)
- Most iconic site in Russia
- Built under orders of Ivan the Terrible
- The Imperial Russian is one of the most famous ballet companies in the world. Cost \$500

Day 8: Travel to Vietnam & Visit the Cu Chi Tunnels

- These are the 200 km of tunnels the Viet Cong created and used during the Vietnam War

• Cost \$162 per night, 2 nights= \$324






Day 9: Go on a Tour of Hoi An

• Cost 2,500 Thai Baht (\$75.65)




Day 12: Travel to Cape Town South Africa Visit Robben Island

 (and may other African animals)




Day 14: Relax at the Pumba Game Reserve

Day 15: Travel Back to the USA!


